Winter 2024 FAQ

Do you offer early admission?

Offers are sent on an ongoing basis from December until the end of May, and applicants are assessed throughout those months (see full chart at guelphhumber.ca/futurestudents/high-school-ON-apply).

Do you accept repeated courses, summer school, night school and correspondence?

The University will use the highest grade reported for grade 12 courses taken at a Ministry-approved school prior to June 2024, regardless of format.

How are grade 11 marks used in admission?

Where the six 4U/M courses, including subject requirements, are not available, we will use completed or in-progress 4U/M and completed 3U/M courses.
